Christian Exodus and the New Media Revolution in Politics

I can hardly contain my excitement for what I think next year holds for the Christian constitutionalist movement. I believe it will prove to be our biggest year yet. We are witnessing an organic, spontaneous organizing of the remnant in America like never before. The catalyst is the Ron Paul candidacy for president in the Republican Party. There is quite frankly a peaceful "revolution" occurring against the established system. I have often mentioned to CE members and news reporters that routine use of the Internet by virtually all Americans is less than 10 years old, and is a completely unpredictable wild card when considering its impact on the political scene. Well, it's not a wild card anymore! It is rapidly proving to be the great equalizer transforming everyday Americans into high powered politicos. For example, the Internet enabled "average joes" to raise over \$6 million for Ron Paul's campaign in one 24-hour period without spending a dime on advertising! The implications of that feat should absolutely astound you! Gone are the muzzles on the mouths and the oppressive boots on the necks of the American people.

Let me put this development in perspective for you. Think of the most revolutionary developments to ever change an industry: the printing press for pub-

lishing, electricity for lighting, radio for communication, television for advertising, digital for music, computers for the information industry, etc.; the Internet is that revolutionary to the political industry. Second, it means Christian Exodus will grow and is needed now more than ever. Let me be absolutely clear that the "revolution" we're witnessing in this election cycle will NOT lead to national reform through the federal government. Even if Ron Paul were to win the White House and miraculously avoid assassination by the Establishment, Congress and the Courts would remain as tyrannical as ever. And let's not forget that politicians don't control the

government anyway; special interests do. Powers far greater than Congressmen and Justices rule the General Government. The road to real reform is through local and State interposition and nullification, and if necessary, independence. Are we to believe that any victories achieved at the national level will be long-lived without a complete overhaul of how our States do business with Washington? Let's not be so naïve. We need a massive changing of the guard at the county and State levels if anything accomplished in Washington is to stick. And that's why CE is needed more than ever. We are one of the very few organizations upon the national stage making the argument that the States, the counties and the People must not tolerate Washington's illegal behavior and must in fact refuse to comply with its unconstitutional directives. Only an attitude of "not in our state, not in our county, not in our schools; we will not obey your illegal orders" will protect our liberties from the tyrannical reach of Washington. So it falls upon our shoulders to get Jefferson's message of interposition and nullification to as many people awakened by the current electoral "revolution" as possible.

Christian Exodus Expands Beyond South Carolina

Several Christian Exodus members realize that due to commitments to extended family or other reasons, they will not be moving to South Carolina.

They believe in the Christian Exodus philosophy of accelerating the return to self-government by Biblical principles through planned migration, local representative government, and the interposition of the lesser magistrate. They withhold blind allegiance to human government as a supreme power, and rec-

ognize its proper function as a servant of the people- to protect and preserve their God-given civil rights.

Idaho is recognized as a place where individual freedoms are still somewhat respected, and where one might raise up their children in the way they should go, rather than in the way that government indoctrination centers would lead them. Idaho is perhaps the most home-school friendly place in America. No government notification is required,

nor any reporting of curriculum or progress in schooling.

As a recommended area of settlement, Gem County strikes a balance in the state between a rural area with economical real estate prices, and yet it is within commuting distance to the metropolitan areas of Boise and Nampa.

Paul Smith— Christian Pioneer to Idaho

Paul Smith made the journey from California to Idaho three years ago in the search for a last bastion of liberty in America. Having found several other like-minded friends, and anticipating more to come, he has decided to stay.

He believes that the sovereign rule of Jesus Christ and the timeless truths of the Word of God extend their authority over every sphere of human existence, including law and human government.

Paul has been a loud Christian voice in the public area, protesting abortion, immorality, and unjust taxation. Being very active in the Constitution Party of Idaho, he ran for U.S. Congress in 2006. Voters received an education in the supremacy of Biblical law, and the classic Laissez-faire economics of Frederic Bastiat.

He resigned from the Constitution Party on principle shortly thereafter, because of their compromise on abortion, in which they succumbed to the official Mormon position of allowing abortion in cases of rape, incest, threats to the life or health of the mother, and fetal deformity.

Paul is often confrontational, but also courteous. Last year, he went out in the midst of a gay parade with his professional audio and video equipment, interviewing marchers, and asking them where their rights came from. When this often drew blank stares, he would lead them to the conclusion that there are no true human rights except as a gift from God above. These are the kind of people who may never walk into a church, and are rarely confronted with a relevant Christian message.

Believing that God has placed him in Idaho for a reason, Paul has volunteered to help coordinate and represent Christian Exodus in Idaho. The hope is to bring together a faithful remnant of Christian activists in the Northwest, where they might home-school their children in the context of Christian community, and stand ready to refuse to be counted as mere cogs in the machine of a totalitarian system that admits no authority higher than its own.

If you feel that it might be in your own best interests to live in Idaho, we encourage you to seek the will of God for your life, and evaluate potential opportunities there. This is not an invitation to quiet isolation, but for bold witness: like a city set on a hill.

Second North American Secessionist Convention

“Our system of government is broken and cannot be fixed.” Cory Burnell announced the results of a recent poll of the Opinion Research Corporation in which 71% of Americans were said to agree with this statement. This became the unwritten theme of the Second North American Secessionist Convention, held in Chattanooga, Tennessee, on 10/3–10/4.

Long past all hope for the possibility of any meaningful reform, the Federal Government has become more alien to the best interests of “We The People” of the several states than King George III. The only lawful and peaceful

prospect left for self-government in America today is that of secession.

It is anticipated that an over-extended and completely bankrupt empire will lose the means to force the iron to cleave to the mirey clay, leaving the individual States to take care of their own problems as best they can, like the various satellite states of the former Soviet Union, or the different ethnic groups of former Yugoslavia.

Delegates from various secessionist groups with chapters in 26 States represented a diverse cross-section of American

culture. The prominent hosts and spokesmen for the convention were Michael Hill of the League of the South, and Thomas Naylor of the Second Vermont Republic.

The old dialectic of left vs. right, or liberal vs. conservative, seemed like a comical delusion of a generation past—it felt like everyone had awoken from a bad dream to realize that we all shared a common desire to be free of the tyranny and oppression of Washington D.C., regardless of which direction we wished to go on our own. We shared various ideas and strategies around the table of how this might be accomplished.

There were Southern Patriots in attendance from all walks of life, coming from all over the South, and even some from as far away as Oregon.

Michael Hill shared recent happenings from the Secession Convention, and the national publicity that was generated. There was also much talk about distribution of the new League of the South newspaper— the Free Magnolia. Modeled on the Vermont Commons, which has had significant success in promoting the idea of a Second Vermont Republic, this newspaper was a new strategy to bring the ideas of Southern Independence to the public.

Kirkpatrick Sale also spoke about secession— trends in world government, and the various secession movements within America.

Donnie Kennedy shared his desire to spread the message of State’s Rights and local sovereignty though a potential run for the presidency. Since the presidential campaign of Ron Paul was already championing the cause of liberty, the general sentiment was that even if victory for Ron Paul were possible, he would soon be assassinated (perhaps by the same powers who had made arrangements for the demise of John F. Kennedy.)

Rev. Gene Case spoke about the increasing encroachments of the police state, with stories gleaned from our friend in Idaho, William Norman Grigg. (prolibertate.us)

Historian John Chodes told the story of a divided Maryland, subjected to martial law by the subterfuge and deception of Abraham Lincoln.

Franklin Sanders delivered the closing address on the various red herrings that would divert the cause, leading up to “The Great Red Herring - Liberty”, saying, “the goal of our secession is not liberty - the goal is obedience to God—and creating the society where that is possible.” He shared his vision from the Valley of Dry Bones, in which God could bring a nation to life from the ashes.

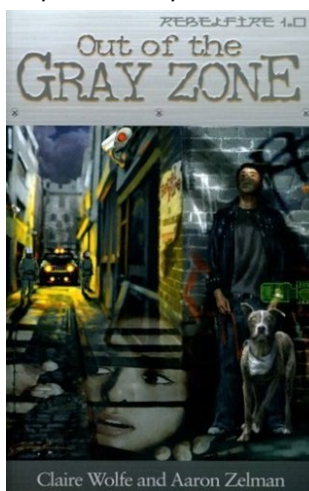

RebelFire: Out of the Gray Zone by Claire Wolfe and Aaron Zelman

This is an engaging futuristic science fiction novel which envisions a comprehensive police state in America, with spy cams, chipped humans, and government management of every area of life- an eerie extrapolation of current trends. It's a modern reflection of George Orwell's worst nightmare, with a captivating plot, and masterful character development.

The protagonist is a teenage boy with an uncontainable yearning to be free, and although the target audience seems to be American teenage boys, it has a very rich vocabulary, with historical and literary allusions to



challenge even the most well-educated adults. Although it is not a Christian novel, true Christians are portrayed in a

positive light; and the main character is virtuous and chaste, trying to do what is right, no matter what the cost, in a world gone mad.

The authors are from Jews for the Preservation of Firearms Ownership, and so the book cries out for the defense of freedom from cover to cover. It is full of relevant object lessons for the survival of free people, and the story stays with you. In the midst of some new intrusion upon liberty, I often find myself turning to my son to say, "Remember when Jeremy faced the situation in which..."
